Uniform Dress Code: Grammar Boys 5-6

Bold italic items make up the formal uniform (typically worn on Wednesday's), which is acceptable to wear on any day. All pieces of the formal uniform are required to be worn on formal uniform days and must be worn for the entire day. Everyday items are optional and include the updates for the 2023-2024 school year.

SHIRTS

- White Oxford Shirt, long or short sleeve Paideia logo permitted, but not required
- Polo shirt with Paideia logo: Red (cotton or performance; short- or long-sleeved)

TIE (end of tie must fall at the top of belt buckle)

• Solid navy tie

PANTS

• Navy pants - plain front or pleated, no skinny fit

SHORTS

• Classic Navy, knee length

BELT (must be worn at all times)

• Solid dark brown, navy or black

SOCKS

- Solid navy or black dress socks
- Solid black, gray, or white (ankle or crew socks)

SHOES

- Dark brown or black solid-color leather dress shoes boat, lace-up or loafer
- Low-top only athletic shoes (required for PE), in neutral colors only of navy, black, brown, white, or gray; no color accents on soles, laces, or body of shoe; no characters, lights, or decorations
- No boots, sandals, backless, open toes, clog-style, moccasins, or boat shoes

WARMTH LAYER

- Sweater: Navy with logo (V-Neck or Crew)
- Sweatshirt: Navy with logo
- Fleece: Navy with logo

OUTERWEAR

- Any items worn in the classroom and in the cafeteria must have the school logo. These include the navy sweaters, vests, fleece sweatshirts, etc.
- Students may wear non-logo coats, jackets, sweatshirts, and sweaters to school in the morning, home from school in the afternoon, and outdoors (to recess and PE).

- White no-show, ankle, or crew socks
